Boater's Education – AR Game & Fish Commission

Anyone born on or after January 1, 1986 and of legal age to operate a motorboat (including personal watercraft) or sailboat must have successfully completed an approved AGFC Boating Education Course and carry proof while operating a motorboat or sailboat on Arkansas water. This one-day course is recommended for ages 12 and up. Family participation is encouraged. *Parental consent form is required for youth under 18 years of age.* Form can be found on AGFC website.
