Forty-five (45) junior/senior hours are required to complete the BS degree. This includes 18 hours in the business core, 24 hours in the major, and 3 hours of upper-level electives. These must be taken at a four-year college or university. Arkansas State University College of Business requires 30 of the last 36 hours be taken from A-State.
