

Graduation Frequently Asked Questions

1. If I applied for my degree in Campus Connect, is that the same thing as applying for graduation?
--Yes
2. Will I receive my diploma the night of graduation?
--No. *The graduation ceremony is held **before** the semester ends. Degrees are not conferred and diplomas are not printed until after final grades are received. You will receive an e-mail when diplomas are ready--usually 6-8 weeks after the term ends.*
3. Where can I get a cap and gown?
--Caps and gowns will be available in the Bookstore until graduation.
4. If I do not make it to Graduation Planning Day, can I still participate?
--Yes
5. If I selected that I did not want to participate on my application, can I still participate that night?
--Yes, you can still participate.
6. Can I still participate in graduation if I did not submit my application before the deadline?
--Yes
7. Will my name still be called if I did not submit my application before the deadline?
--Yes, your name will be called. *The night of graduation, you will receive an index card with your name on it to present to the name reader.*
8. I qualify for several degrees; do I have to apply for each one?
--Yes, you have to complete a separate application for each degree you are seeking.
