Dear Vanguard Community,

Please be advised that clinical rotations for ASU-Beebe students in health professions programs are suspended until at least March 30, 2020. To-date, the potential exposure to the Coronavirus for students and employees at Arkansas higher education institutions has been largely through clinical rotations at health care facilities. Suspending clinical instruction is a prudent precautionary measure.

Students in programs with clinical rotations will be contacted by their program directors and/or faculty concerning alternative methods of instruction. At this time, all classroom instruction will continue as scheduled.

Again, I want to emphasize that there have been no cases of COVID 19 among ASU-Beebe faculty, staff, or students at this time. The risk to our campus community is minimal at this point; however, we want to be prepared should conditions change.
