Today ASU-Beebe Administration learned that two positive cases of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) have been reported in Cleburne County. We do not have any information regarding whether any of our students, faculty or staff have had contact or been exposed, or if these individuals may have visited campus recently.

As a conservative measure in the interest of ensuring the health and safety of the students, faculty and staff of the ASU-Beebe Heber Springs Campus, we will close the campus for one business day, Tuesday, March 17, 2020, to facilitate a thorough deep cleaning.

All ASU-Beebe Heber Springs Campus facilities will close Monday, March 16 (today) at 5 p.m. and will reopen at 8 a.m. on Wednesday, March 18, 2020. All employees of the Heber Springs Campus will work from home on Tuesday. Students are not to report to the Heber Springs Campus on Tuesday, March 17. Anyone needing to contact the Heber Springs campus should call 501-362-1100.

Courses will continue to be delivered online or through an alternate method of instruction. The Advising and Learning Center will reopen on Wednesday, March 18 at 8 a.m. for student use.
