

## Explanation of Four Semester Plan

This degree plan is a recommended plan of study which may require adjustments to fit individual situations such as semester course load, summer courses, transfer coursework, courses repeated or developmental courses required.

This plan should be used with a degree checksheet to ensure all requirements are met for completion of the degree. Students should meet with an assigned faculty advisor at least once a semester to ensure that the plan is appropriate for the desired academic path.

## **PLANS OF STUDY**

The ASU-Beebe Education Department works closely with ASU-Jonesboro and UCA to provide seamless transfer for students in education areas. The 2+2 program plans of study for each area below are specific to the institution, so it is important for students to know to which university they intend to transfer.

**The Associate of Science in Education is available for the following areas of study:**

- Kindergarten – 6<sup>th</sup> grade
- Mid-Level 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> (Language Arts/Math)
- Mid-Level 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> (Language Arts/Science)
- Mid-Level 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> (Language Arts/Soc Studies)
- Mid-Level 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> (Math/Science)

## **DEVELOPMENTAL COURSES**

Developmental courses are required based on placement scores. Each course listed below has a corresponding placement score (from ACT, Accuplacer, etc.) that determines which level of MATH or ENGLISH is required. Academic Advisors will assist students with registering for the correct developmental course as required.

Placement test scores are not final. Students may choose to retake the Accuplacer test after discussing with an academic advisor.

Developmental courses and credit hours are not applied toward the degree plan hours.
