- Students making formal application into the ASU Teacher Education Program must meet the following admission requirements:**
1. Attain minimum passing scores on the Praxis CORE Tests for Reading 162, Math 162, and Writing 165 tests OR the ACT with scores of at least 19 in reading and mathematics, and 7 in English/Writing. If one or more of the ACT exams do not meet the qualifying scores you may take a single CORE exam.
  2. Attain minimum overall GPA of a 2.70.
  3. Complete ENG 1003, ENG 1013, MATH 1023 or 1043!, SCOM 1203 and Introduction to Education classes with a grade of "C" or better in each.
  4. Complete minimum of 30 semester hours.
  5. Complete an evaluation of Career Decision Awareness.
  6. Submit a completed application form.
  7. Complete the Professional Dispositions Self-Assessment as prescribed in the Teacher Education Handbook.
  8. Submit a signed Clarification of Teacher Education Admission/Retention Standards.
  9. Appear individually for a personal interview.
  10. Verify no conviction of a felony or crimes.
  11. Verify that student has received a copy of the Mission & Values, Teacher Education Outcomes and Arkansas Teaching Standards.
