Campus Security Notice - Timely Notice for Coronavirus

Vanguard Community,

A positive case of coronavirus has been reported in the Arkansas State University-Beebe community. A Searcy Campus student has notified ASU-Beebe of a positive test result, and in accordance with guidance from public health officials at the county and state levels, this Clery Act notice is being sent to inform all ASU-Beebe faculty, staff and students on all campuses of this development.

The student was last on campus on March 13, 2020, and has had no contact with any ASU-Beebe employee or student since that time. The student self-isolated once they became symptomatic and continues in self-isolation at this time. The student received their positive test result March 31, and notified a faculty member of those results on April 4.

The Beebe, Searcy, and Heber Springs campuses of ASU-Beebe remain open to support the ongoing operations of classroom instruction via alternative methods of instruction/remote delivery, and to assist students who live on the campus. Until further notice, ASU-Beebe services are being provided remotely through Zoom video conferencing, CANVAS, Skype, via phone call, etc. The [ASUB Remote Services contact information page](#) is available to assist students who need access to services.
