Banner Self-Service is NOW available for students!

Stay in the loop and never miss another deadline or important information within Banner Self-Service.

At <u>my.ASUB.edu</u>, students can now access information and documents through Banner Self-Service (previously accessed through the Vanguard Portal).

Within the Banner Self-Service portal, you can:

- Register for your classes
- · Add or drop classes
- View and print class schedule
- Review your transcript
- Check placement test scores
- View holds on your account
- Check for Financial Aid eligibility

Billing information for Fall 2022 is anticipated to be available on August 1. Students will be permitted to view their balance, apply payments, and create payment plans on their account once this is available.
