- 2. Attain minimum overall GPA of a 2.70.
- 3. Complete ENG 1003, ENG 1013, MATH 1023 oe 1043!, SCOM 1203 and Introduction to Education classes with a grade of "C" or better in each.
- 4. Complete minimum of 30 semester hours.
- 5. Complete an evaluation of Career Decision Awareness.

- 6. Submit a completed application form.
- 7. Complete the Professional Dispositions Self-Assessment as prescribed in the Teacher Education Handbook.
- 8. Submit a signed Clarification of Teacher Education Admission/Retention Standards.
- 9. Appear individually for a personal interview.
- 10. Verify no conviction of a felony or crimes.
- 11. Verify that student has received a copy of the Mission & Values, Teacher Education Outcomes and Arkansas Teaching Standards.
