ASU-BEEBE CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT FUNDING PROGRAMS

Concurrent Challenge Scholarship Act 456

Free/Reduced Lunch Participants Act 1118

Who is Eligible?

- Act 456 Arkansas Code (§ 6-85-403 (b); provides available concurrent scholarship funding for students who are an Arkansas resident or child of Arkansas resident.
- High School Sophomores, Juniors, or Seniors who attend an ASU-Beebe partnered high school with a current signed MOU.

Who is Eligible?

Act 1118 Arkansas Code (§ 6-16-1204 (e) (1) (B); provides reduced college tuition for students eligible for free/reduced lunches provided by the National School Lunch Program (NSLP).

What is Awarded?

 Eligible students shall be awarded \$125 up to 2 eligible courses for the fall and spring terms.

What is Awarded?

 Student may obtain tuition funding for a maximum of six credit hours during their high school career.

What courses are covered?

- ASU-Beebe General Education courses and courses listed on the Arkansas Course Transfer System (ACTS).
- Non-General Education Course taught by ASU-Beebe as part of a certificate program.
- The course must be taken to fulfill a high school graduation requirement.

What courses are covered?

- Course must be listed on the Arkansas Course Transfer System (ACTS).
- Course taught on a high school campus in a classroom (no web courses).
- Course taught by qualified high school faculty.

Award Requirements?

- Student must have an academic success plan on file with the high school counseling office.
- Student must successfully complete the current semester and receive a minimum college grade point average of 2.5.
- ASU-Beebe will submit funding requests to ADHE on behalf of students.

Award Requirements?

- High school must certify the student's eligibility for the National School Lunch Program using federal guidelines.
- High school will provide wavier forms to the Concurrent Enrollment office for processing of tuition waivers with ASU-Beebe.

The concurrent (High School) tuition rate is assessed at the full off-campus rate and discounted by a waiver to \$125 for eligible courses. The concurrent tuition rate may be subject to change pending legislative and/or institutional policy changes. Students are responsible for paying concurrent tuition if a funding program is unavailable or they do not meet eligibility requirements.
