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The MA-C Program is located on the Searcy campus of ASU-Beebe in the Beulah Bloodworth (Nursing) building. It is offered during Spring Term II and Fall Term II.

The course is eight (8) weeks long. Classes are on Tuesday and Wednesday from 8:00-4:00.

The MA-C program has a **closed** registration. The nursing department must verify eligibility before students can be enrolled in the course.

In order to enroll in the course an applicant **MUST**:

1. Have a least one continuous year of full-time experience as a CNA in Arkansas.
2. Currently be listed in good standing on the state's certified nurse aide registry
3. Be currently employed at a long-term care facility
4. Have a high school diploma or the equivalent
5. Successfully complete a literacy and reading comprehension screening process (Accuplacer) approved by the Board (OLTC).

Steps to enrollment

1. Apply and complete the steps necessary for admission to the University. This will include turning in all necessary documentation and entrance exams.
2. Contact the nursing department:

3. Turn in required documentation from place of employment.
 - a. Employment Verification Form
 - b. Current TB skin test
4. Once eligibility has been determined, student will be registered for the course by the nursing department.
