The Office of Disability Services is located in the Student Success Center within the McKay Student Center, on the second floor in Suite 202, at the main campus in Beebe.

The **Coordinator of Disability Services** is Tisha L. Marzewski, a certified Rehabilitation Counselor who joined the ASU-Beebe staff in 2007. Contact her by calling (501) 882-8906 or sending an email to tmarzewski@asub.edu.

Among the **disability services we offer** are:

- Reasonable Academic & Non-Academic Accommodations, such as classroom and testing accommodations
- Alternative Format for Educational Materials, including Braille, Large Print or audio format
- Support personnel, such as interpreters, readers, writers and note-takers
- Assistive Technology, including screen readers and FM systems
- Advocacy and Study Skills Guidance. such as techniques for time management and study skills

To access Disability Services, please follow these steps:

1. Schedule an Interview appointment with the Coordinator of Disability Services
2. Submit disability documentation to provide information regarding your disability
3. Meet with the Coordinator of Disability Services to discuss and determine appropriate accommodations for the current class schedule.

ADVISING & LEARNING CENTER

The **Advising and Learning Center** manages free academic advising and tutoring services for all ASU-Beebe students from its location in the McKay Student Center at the Beebe campus. It provides these services to students enrolled at all four ASU-Beebe campuses and in ASU-Beebe online courses.

Academic advisors are available year-round and trained to assist students in multiple areas of interest.

Tutoring is available from professional and peer tutors in a variety of disciplines including mathematics, science, English, business and more.

Convenient hours of operation throughout the year make advising and tutoring easy to access, with extended hours during fall and spring semesters at ASU-Beebe and ASU-Beebe at Heber Springs.

Computer Labs are available for your convenience, including a large, open computer lab at the Advising and Learning Center at the Beebe campus.

Other resources include group study rooms, calculators, study skills/test preparation, textbooks, study materials, handouts, and literature notes. Placement testing is available at all four campuses.

FINANCIAL AID

The **ASU-Beebe Financial Aid Office** is dedicated to helping students find and apply for available resources to pay for education or training expenses. Examples of student educational expenses include tuition, fees, books, supplies, room and board. The Financial Aid office administers a variety of financial aid programs, such as grants, scholarships, loans, work study employment, veteran educational benefits and military tuition assistance.

Helpful information about financial aid programs is available from the U.S. Department of Education website commonly referred to as FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). The website is <https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa>. The FAFSA is a commonly required application that determines eligibility for a variety of financial aid programs.

Students pursuing financial aid will have access to their financial aid data and status through their ASU-Beebe student Vanguard Portal account online.

Veterans Educational Benefits
